DHHS Guidelines: Moving Forward

This presentation examines the latest treatment guidelines with regards to treatment initiation as well as the evolution of HIV care. We will also look at how CD4 count can effect long term complications and can folks reduce their own risk. This presentation also makes reference to heart disease, cancer, as well as renal and hepatic complications.

HIV and Women

This program focuses on the total health of women with HIV. It discusses depression, child care, as well as family care. We will also examine the key issues that effect women i.e. drug metabolism and how to empower.

APAN Program: Atripla Patient Advocate Network

This is a unique and dynamic program in the form of peer to peer education. It examines disclosure, adherence, and client/provider communication. This presentation is very interactive. We also discuss the multitude of options available to folks who are positive.

Understanding Labs
